

PERSONAL DATA CONSENT
resulting from art. 13 of GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation)

1. The Participant's personal data administrator is the University of Bialystok, address: Świerkowa 20B, 15-328 Białystok.
2. The Participant may contact the Data Protection Officer in all matters regarding the processing of personal data and the exercise of rights related to data processing via the e-mail address: iod@uwb.edu.pl
3. The Participant's personal data will be processed for the purposes of participation in the Summer School. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary for participation in the Summer School. If the Participant will not provide data, it will not be possible to implement the abovementioned purpose.
4. The legal basis for processing personal data is based on art. 6 clause 1 letter b and c of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation):
 - the need to participate in the Summer School.
5. The Administrator will store the Participant's data for the duration of the Summer School, as well as for the duration of any claims related thereto, arising from the Civil Code.
6. The Participant's personal data may be transferred to processors and public authorities or bodies authorized to obtain data on the basis of applicable law, e.g. courts, law enforcement authorities or state institutions, when they make a request, based on an appropriate legal basis.
7. Participants have the following rights related to the processing of personal data:
 - a) the right to access to personal data,
 - b) the right to request the rectification of personal data that is incorrect and to supplement incomplete personal data,
 - c) the right to request the deletion of personal data,
 - d) the right to request restriction of personal data processing,
 - e) the right to transfer personal data, i.e. the right to receive personal data in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable IT format,
 - f) the right not to be subject only to automated decision making, including profiling,
 - g) the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory body dealing with the protection of personal data, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
